#### 1. Apologies for absence

1.1 Apologies were received from Councillor C Farr due to prior personal commitments. **RESOLVED** - The meeting was deemed quorate.

#### 2. Declaration of Interest

2.1 It was noted that there were no specific pecuniary interests to the item on the agenda, but that 3 of the councilors present are parishioners who pay towards the council precept.

#### 3. Minutes of previous meetings held on 11 August 2023

3.1 The committee reviewed the minutes of the meeting held on 11 August 2023.

### 4.5 On reviewing the reserves, the committee proposed the following recommendations be made to council:

Noting that council had been updated at November meeting on funding requirements and advised of a new grant application being made.

4.7 It was noted that the committee would still need to consider further tree works in the budget for 24-25. There was discussion to ensure that there was clarity on tree works that will still remain and what was covered in the tree survey in addition to any budget allocation for dealing with unplanned tree works.

**ACTION FC11/23 – 1 –** Cllr I Smith and Clerk to liaise with Tree Contractor to confirm that the areas covered by the survey are correctly understood.

**ACTION FC11/23 – 2 –** If work proceeds following councils' approval, clear information on tree work completed to be requested to update councils' records.

4.8 The committee considered funds unspent on some budget lines and uncommitted.

**RESOLVED** – The committee confirmed that £2,860 from the Election budget that would not be required be a virement to the Tree Budget code.

**ACTION FC11/23 – 2 -** Clerk to complete Virement of budget lines detailed.

4.9 The committee considered funds available from General reserves (after budgeted items accounted for). As of 30 September 2023, there is £25,306 available which could also be called upon to cover the cost of tree works.

- 4.10 It was further noted that the council always has a precept reserve, which for FY23-24 is £36,609. The council could draw on this reserve temporarily to cover the cost of tree works if deemed necessary.
- 4.11 The committee considered the commitment to purchase the Bounty in line with the review of funds for tree works and if the purchase proceeds before the loan is confirmed and received and funds are used for tree works.
- 4.12 The committee noted the recently received funds from the Fete Committee of £600.
